Fanny Mann obtained her PhD in 1999 from the University Claude Bernard Lyon I. She then did a postdoc at the University of Cambridge before being recruited to the CNRS in 2003. Since 2012, she has been leading a research team at the Institute of Developmental Biology in Marseille that studies the development of neural networks and their ability to reorganize in organs affected by cancer. More specifically, her research aims to identify the biochemical and mechanical mechanisms that cooperate to stimulate tumor innervation and to evaluate the importance of nerve-tumor interactions in disease progression.
