Vincent Prévot is currently Senior Research Director at the Inserm and heads the laboratory of "Development and Plasticity of the Neuroendocrine Brain" at the Lille Neuroscience & Cognition research center in France since 2007. Following his Ph.D. under Jean-Claude Beauvillain, he undertook a postdoctoral work at the Oregon National Primate Research Center/Oregon Health & Science University, USA in the laboratory of Sergio R. Ojeda. He then returned to France to take up a tenured Researcher position at the Inserm in 2002, establishing an independent research group at Lille.

His current research focuses on Systems Neuroscience and Neuroendocrinology, in particular the brain circuits that control reproduction and metabolism and the neural pathways through which they respond to peripheral information.

He participates in and has served on the Scientific Commissions of Inserm and the Executive Committees of several learned societies, and currently holds the position of President of the International Neuroendocrinology Federation (INF), and of the Belgium FNRS Neuroscience commission (SVS-3) as well as Past-Treasurer of the Federation of European Neuroscience Societies (FENS).
